

Article V: Organization of the Government

Section 1. Branches of Government The power of the government shall be divided among the Legislative Branch, The Judicial Branch, and the Executive Branch.

Section 2. Separation of Powers No official of any branch of government shall exercise the authority granted in this Constitution or properly delegated by law to any other branch except as expressly directed or permitted by this Constitution. The final check of power will be the maximum reasonable involvement of the Monacan people.

Section 3. Location of Government The capital of the Monacan Nation shall be Bear Mountain at approximately: (37.594376, 79.112986) Longitude, Latitude.

Section 4. Governing Rules This Constitution and "Roberts Rules of Order" shall govern the business and affairs conducted by the Nation's Government.
